

Foot Pedal Replacement Instructions

Follow instructions provided to ensure safety. Consult personal or company procedures as needed. Contact 911 Blasters with questions or concerns at 251-580-8537 or by email at office@911blasters.com.

- 1) Turn off pump and light power switches. Disconnect the GFCI from the outlet.



- 2) Turn off the air supply to the air line if able. Disconnect the air line from the foot pedal.



- 3) Cut the hose connecting the cabinet to the old foot pedal just above the fitting.



- 4) Crimp the o-clamp around the new hose ensuring a tight fit. It is best to use o-clamp pliers shown.
